Growing up on the beautiful Caribbean island of Antigua, I had the blessing of being raised by my grandmother. Until I turned 13, she nurtured me with love, wisdom, and purpose. My grandmother instilled in me a deeply rooted philosophy: to serve others with a selfless heart. "Nikki," (my home name) she would say, "there are always those less fortunate than you. Do your best to help them." Those words have echoed in my heart and become the foundation of Reaching Out Now.

Even now, in her 80s, her heart remains a beacon of service. Each day, she rises at 3AM to lift her family, church, and community in prayer. Neighbors know they can always count on her for a warm meal or an encouraging word, our deacon knows she would come in a heartbeat when called, and her prayers feel like a protective barrier around our family.

Life is funny; I married into a family that shares this passion. Joe's parents devoted over 30 years to their homeless ministry, packing meals and offering compassion at their church in West Palm Beach each week. My mother-in-law's guiding principle was simple but profound: "Treat others the way you want to be treated."

Today, Joe and I raise our children with this legacy of servant leadership—to love, give, serve, and walk humbly, knowing they're destined to make a difference.

Our Empowerment initiatives are rooted in empowering individuals and strengthening our community. By fostering connections, celebrating contributions, and providing meaningful support, we uplift those around us and aim to create lasting impacts that extend far beyond each event.

Junior Senior Planning Night

Designed to help high school juniors and seniors explore their future pathways, this evening brings together representatives from workforce programs, colleges, and military branches. In 2023, we helped **over 50 attendees from Warren, Frederick, and Shenandoah Counties and Winchester City** plan their paths for the future.

Our Leadership program always brings us the biggest smiles. This is the heart and soul of our organization, working with students to help them see and reach their full potentials. This year, just like every year before it, was the best and we are blessed to be able to support such a wonderful group of kids.

YES Leadership Program

2024's mentorship program had **15 incredible** students from both Warren and Shenandoah counties. We held a total of **27 workshops** and volunteering events totaling in **376** hours of commitment from our students.

We also had our **largest group of graduating students yet**, six total, who we couldn't be more proud of! Cheyenne, Syre, and Kaleb are all moving on to Laurel Ridge Community College, Isabel is attending Lincoln Tech, Trinity is attending cosmetology school and Mia plans to join the military. Each of these students were offered \$500 scholarships toward their next steps.

YES Conference | The Power of Vision

Our 2023 YES Conference showed amazing growth from the previous year, and allowed us to reach new students through a partnership with **Warren County and Winchester City Public Schools** allowing their students to attend the event as a **swap day**.

The full day conference at Shenandoah University had **90 students from 5 high schools** attended: three speaker sessions, an interactive lunch, a campus tour, and a Q&A session with a panel of professionals. We were also able to award four seniors in attendance with **\$100 scholarships**.

Holiday Cheer & Giving






