LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

The Youth Empowered for Success (YES) Leadership Program is dedicated to developing middle and high-school-age youth into leaders of tomorrow. Upon high school graduation, the students will continue in mentorship opportunities as graduates of the program.

Program meetings will be held on the first and third Saturday of each month and will be conducted in two parts. The program's first hour will be dedicated to the students completing Career and Social modules that focus on essential life skills and fuel engaging conversations. The second hour will consist of practicing and implementing what was discussed in the first hour through a session led by educators or professionals in the fields introduced.

The program is open to students who attend any public, private, or home-based school in the Shenandoah Valley. Students must be in good academic standing with their school and must have a written endorsement from their school principal or school counselor and support from their parent/guardian.

FRAMEWORK STRUCTURE

The YES Leadership Program will consist of four units based on the NOSCA standards of College and Career Readiness with a track specifically geared for male and female students. Session topics are subject to change and interpretation of the presenter and needs of students involved.

- » Units will be measured by pre- and post-tests with an understanding of what students already know, want to learn, and what they learned.
- » Character development will take approximately four to six weeks.
- » Community Leadership/Engagement will be continual throughout the school year.
- » Workforce Readiness (college and career readiness and financial literacy) will be five to six weeks.
- » Academic literacy will be a focus for approximately three weeks and addressed as an ongoing component of the program.


The academic school year sets the timeline for the units with a wrap-up preceding the end of the academic calendar year. The programs require an application and approval from parents and school staff.
